THE COLLECTION

- 638,217 metadata records in central search portal
- Photos, maps, books, artifacts, oral histories
- 390 collections from 240 Wisconsin libraries, archives, historical societies, museums, government agencies, etc.
- State and local history resources as well as materials from across the country and around the world

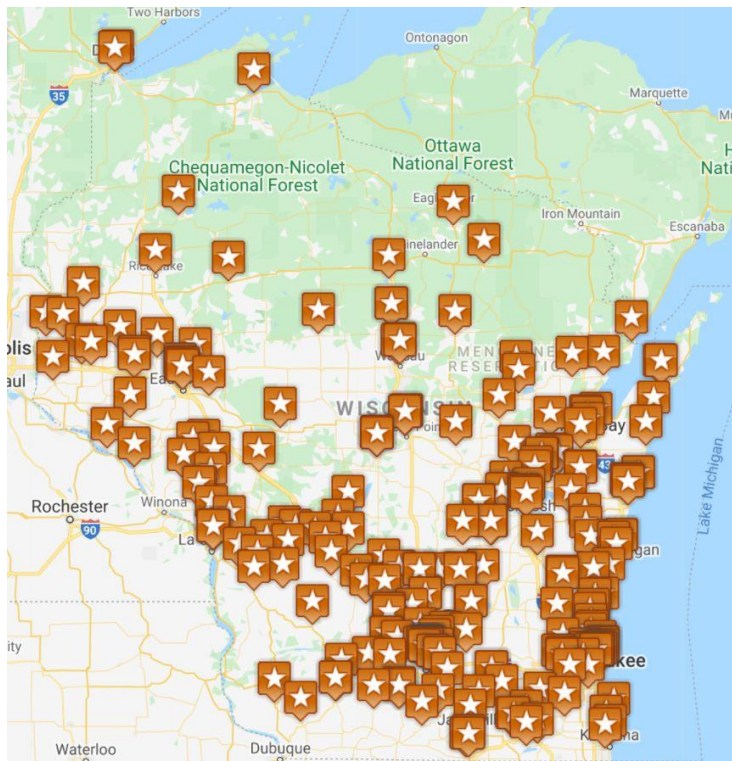

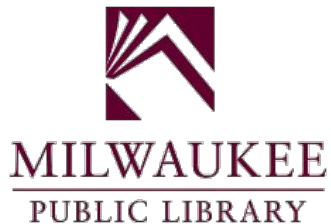

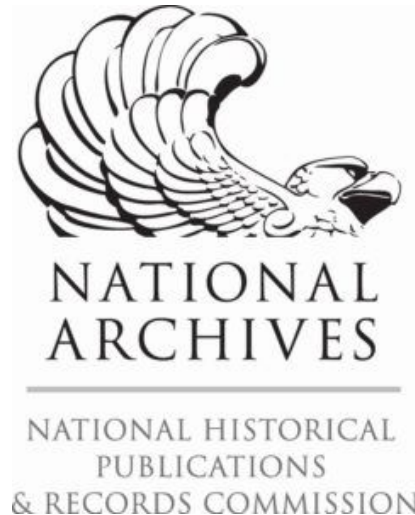
